### **GENERAL DISCIPLINE**

- 1. Student should wear the Uniform prescribed for them.
- 2. Students should get seated in the class-room at least 5 minutes before the commencement of the class.
- 3. Latecomers normally will not be allowed to attend the class.
- 4. They should not deface the classroom furniture in anyway.
- 5. They should not damage or break the electrical fittings of the classroom and laboratories
- 6. They should not write anything on the blackboard.
- 7. They should keep their classrooms neat and clean.
- 8. They should maintain perfect discipline in the class during teaching hours.
- 9. They should not leave the classroom after each period.
- 10. While changing / moving from theory classes to practical classes, they should not make noise in the corridors, so as not to disturb other classes.
- 11. They should read the notices displayed on the notice boards carefully everyday during the recess.
- 12. Students should submit leave applications if he / she remains absent countersigned by their parents / guardians.
- 13. In case of sickness, the leave application should be accompanied by a medical certificate.
- 14. Leave application will not be accounted towards attendance.
- 15. As per University ordinance 85 % attendance is necessary for appearing in the University examination.
- 16. However, the Director can condone 15% attendance in special cases like sickness, sports etc.
- 17. In no case, student having less then 70% attendance will be allowed to appear for University examination.
- 18. They should not write anything on the walls of the college building.
- 19. Cell phones are generally not allowed inside the college building.
- 20. No complaint will be entertained for theft of cell phones possessed unathorizedly.
- 21. Every student must carry his/her I-card and Bus pass all the time during college timings.

### **ACADEMIC INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Every student should have at least one text-book for each theory subject.
- 2. They should have the practical notebook as specified by the teacher concerned.
- 3. They should note down the lectures properly giving the headings along with the date.
- 4. If a student remains absent for a day of two, 2-3 blank pages should be left in the notebook for noting the lecture.
- 5. In every fortnight randomly selected at least five class notebooks will be checked by the Head of the Department and the Director.
- 6. Every Student should have a separate note book for Assignments of each theory subject.
- 7. Home Assignment should be submitted strictly on due date without copying from other students.
- 8. There will be a minimum of two class-tests in each subject.
- 9. They should prepare well for the class test because 20 marks in the University scheme has been allotted for the same.
- 10. The best of two class tests will be sent to university which will get entered in the score-card as it is.
- 11. If any student remains absent In both two class tests, he will be awarded zero marks.
- 12. Every student must have separate note-book for each subject and should have a rough note-book.
- 13. They should go through the instructions given by the teacher concerned before starting the experiment.
- 14. They should record the reading / observation in the practical notebook / observation notebook and get it signed by the teacher before leaving the laboratory.
- 15. If time is left after completion of the experiment they should complete the writing work in their practical record book.
- 16. When they come to the laboratory next time, they should submit their practical record book on the table of the teacher concerned.
- 17. The experiment number and the date of performing the experiment should be entered properly for each and every experiment.
- 18. They should write only those experiments in practical notebooks, which they have preformed actually.
- 19. If time permits, they will be allocated extra slot for performing the experiments during the period when they were absent.
- 20. They should be prepared for answering the viva-voce question.
- 21. Surprise viva-voce test can also be held in the practical class.
- 22. Every student should bring his own calculator every day.

### LIBRARY RULES

- 1. Maximum two books will be issued to each student at a time.
